

Political posters do not require a sign permit but must comply with the following requirements:

- ◆ All signs shall be removed within 5 days of the closing of the polling stations for the relevant election or plebiscite.
- ◆ Signs cannot emit sound, use video features, or be illuminated.
- ◆ Signs shall be maintained in a condition that is neat & shall not be unsightly or dangerous.
- ◆ Signs shall not interfere with or be confused with a traffic control device.
- ◆ Signs shall not interfere with safe and orderly movement of pedestrians or vehicles or restrict the sight lines for pedestrians or motorists.
- ◆ Signs shall not exceed 1.1 metres² in area, 1.2 metres in height, and must be self supporting.
- ◆ Signs shall not be posted for more than 60 days.
- ◆ Signs shall not be posted within the property boundaries of any existing Town owned land or facility, or any sidewalks or road right of way adjacent to Town owned land or facilities, but may be posted on boulevards and road rights of way adjoining parks and playing fields.
- ◆ Signs shall be a minimum of 3 metres from any road access and a minimum of 5 metres from any intersection.
