


Main Street Revitalization Monthly Newsletter

MAIN STREET PROJECT ACHIEVES NEW MILESTONES

Main Street upgrades are well underway. The 17th St intersection is now open to traffic, with the 18th St intersection soon to follow. Tollestrup's crew has started working on the underground sanitary infrastructure upgrades along the 19th St intersection as well as widening the sidewalks and installing bulb-outs.

Tollestrup has also updated the pedestrian and vehicle map (below) as the project progresses. These maps are intended to help residents navigate the streets throughout construction to create minimal disruption for the Main Street businesses. The map is also posted on the Coaldale Main Street Revitalization web page.



BULB-OUT AND CROSSWALK DESIGNS FINALIZED

After consulting with the Main Street business owners and stakeholders, the designs for the bulb-outs and crosswalks have been selected! The designs incorporate beautiful landscaping, space for street furniture, and pedestrian ramps for maximum accessibility. The bulb-outs and crosswalks will be a distinct red colour to increase pedestrian visibility and add an element of interest to the public realm. The herringbone pattern will also add character to Main Street that will distinguish the area from other parts of town.
