### PROJECT UPDATE


The Main Street project has been tendered and construction is set to start in May. This is an exciting milestone for the revitalization of Main Street as we transition out of the design phase and begin seeing the project come to life. Servicing for the project area has also been finalized. Once the tender process closes and the project has been awarded, the successful bidder will be introduced to the community stakeholders and a detailed construction schedule will be released. Additionally, the successful bidder will be required to communicate with all stakeholders in the project area to ensure that the project work will have the lowest possible impact on access to business during construction.
