

**BYLAW 913-P-02-25
TOWN OF COALDALE
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF COALDALE FOR THE PURPOSE
OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN
ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL
GOVERNMENT ACT, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000,
CHAPTER M-26, AS AMENDED.**

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described, and as illustrated in attached 'Schedule A' are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Coaldale deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to, and

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act* by way of advertising the public hearing for this bylaw, held on September 15th, 2025 at 5:00 pm, for two consecutive weeks in a locally circulating newspaper (the Sunny South Newspaper) on September 1st, 2025 and September 8th, 2025, and by mailing notification of the proposed bylaw to adjacent property owners and relevant referral agencies in advance of the public hearing, and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Coaldale in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

**PLAN 241 0242, THAT PORTION OF 14TH STREET
CONTAINED WITHIN PLAN _241 0242_____,
CONTAINING 0.234 HA (0.58 ACRES) MORE OR LESS**

This bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
