**WHEREAS**, this bylaw is a revising bylaw prepared in accordance with Section 63 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, to correct the public hearing and public hearing advertising dates that were incorrectly noted in the original bylaw which is attached as 'Schedule A', but which do not materially impact any aspect of the original bylaw relating to the intent of the bylaw or the process by which it was passed, and

**WHEREAS**, all content of the original bylaw, other than the dates upon which the public hearing was advertised and held, shall remain the same, as shown in 'Schedule A', and

**WHEREAS**, the correct dates the public hearing for the original bylaw was advertised, in accordance with Section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*, was March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026, and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Administrative Officer has certified in writing, which is attached as 'Schedule B', that prior to consideration of first reading of this bylaw, the proposed revisions were prepared in accordance with Section 63 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended.

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF COALDALE FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL A PUBLIC  
ROADWAY**

**WHEREAS**, the lands hereafter described, and as illustrated in attached 'Schedule A' are no longer required for public travel, and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Coaldale deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to, and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act* by way of advertising the public hearing for this bylaw, held on February 23, 2026 at 5:00 pm, for two consecutive weeks in a locally circulating newspaper (the Sunny South Newspaper) on February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and by mailing notification of the proposed bylaw to adjacent property owners and relevant referral agencies in advance of the public hearing, and

**WHEREAS**, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

**NOW THEREFORE** in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Coaldale in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and disposing of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

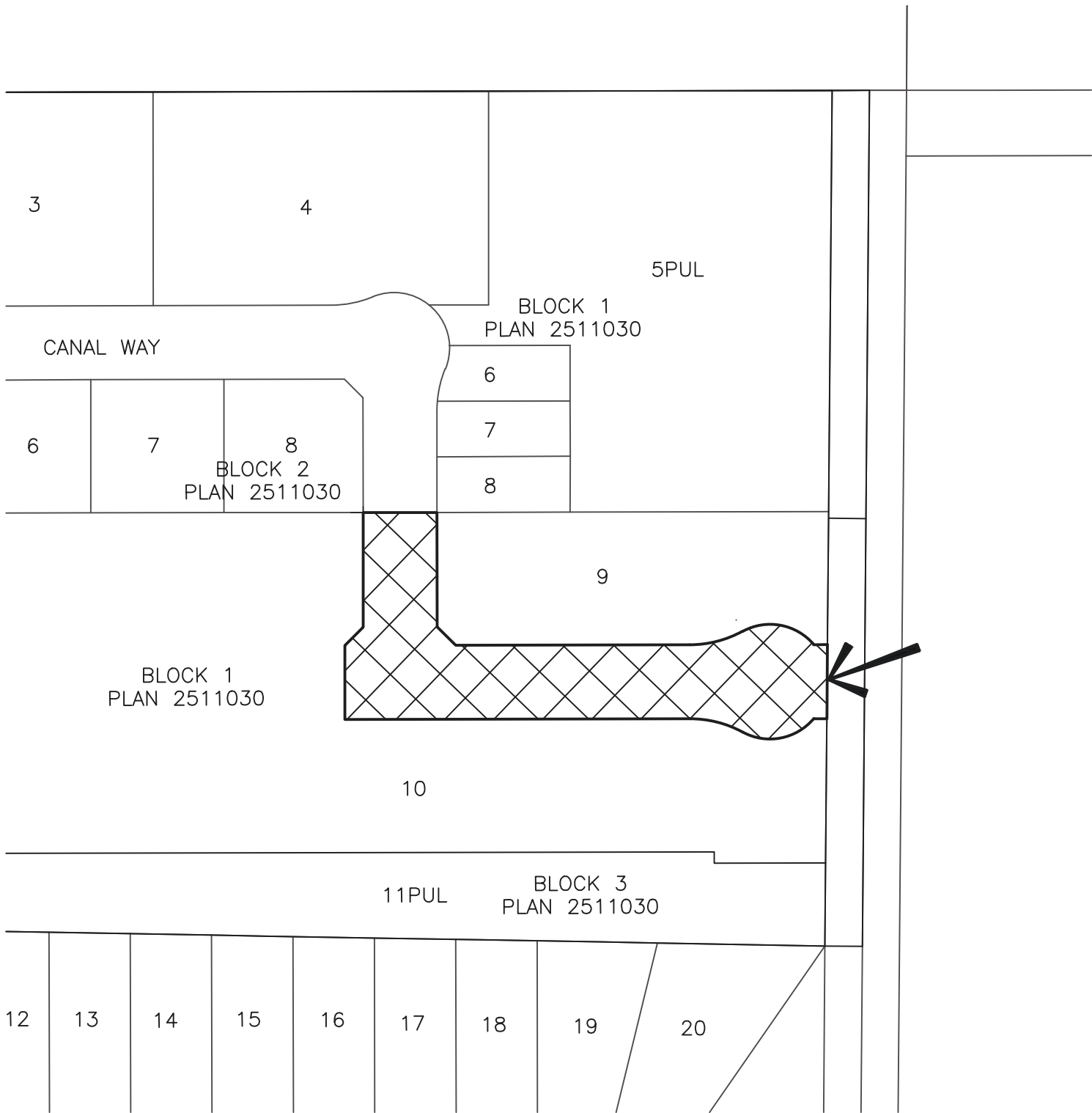
