POLICY SUBJECT: LIVESTREAMING OF COUNCIL MEETINGS

PURPOSE:

To inform the community by livestreaming Council meetings and providing unrestricted access to audio-visual recordings online.

PERSONS AFFECTED:

Town Council and Legislative Services.

POLICY STATEMENTS:

- 1. Council meetings will be livestreamed and recorded as an alternative to attending meetings in-person with the intent of creating additional communication channels that improve the transparency and ease of access to information for the public.
- 2. Audio-visual recordings of Council meetings will be made readily available and accessible to the public online.
- 3. The official record of the meetings shall be the written minutes. The keeping of an audio-visual record of Council meetings will in no way detract or undermine the position of approved minutes as the official record of decision.
- 4. Signage shall be posted to ensure that presenters and members of the public are aware that all public meeting proceedings are being broadcast, recorded, and made available over the internet.
- 5. The meeting may not be recorded should Council meetings be held in a location other than the Council Chambers or if there are unforeseen technical difficulties.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Town Council to:

- a. Utilize the Council Chambers for all public meetings. Exceptions would be made in cases where a larger venue is required because of the anticipated number of citizens in attendance, or a meeting is held with another public body.
- b. Approve policies regarding audio-video recordings of Council meetings.

Legislative Services:

- a. Record and livestream all Council meetings in accordance with the Policy.
- b. Ensure proper backup procedures are followed to ensure that records are retained indefinitely.
