

## REMINDER OF YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- ◆ All dogs must be secured in the back of trucks.
- ◆ Don't leave your pets in a vehicle when it is hot or cold outside; it can endanger their lives.
- ◆ You should never leave your pet unattended for the weekend as there are many problems that can arise in your absence.
- ◆ A restricted dog is any dog that has been determined a "dangerous dog," that is, any dog that shows aggressive behavior to another person or animal regardless of the breed of the dog.
- ◆ All dogs must be on leash when in public. However, be sure to visit our off leash dog park, located on the east of Town—right next to Owl's Nest Campground.
- ◆ Dogs are not allowed in the Cemetery, playgrounds or park areas.
- ◆ Owners must scoop...
- ◆ Owners shall not allow excessive barking.
- ◆ Be sure to have a license and appropriate identification on your dog.
- ◆ The Town does have a dog pound, should your pet escape your yard. Be sure to contact them as soon as possible.
- ◆ All dogs over the age of 6 months must have a Town of Coaldale dog license which can be purchased at the Town Office.
- ◆ If you become a resident of the Town after 14 days you must license your dog.

## EXCESSIVE BARKING

Dogs bark for attention, excitement and to challenge intruders. If you experience barking problems visit the Town of Coaldale website at [www.coaldale.ca](http://www.coaldale.ca) and fill out the Barking Dog Questionnaire or attend the Town Office. This form is required for the Community Peace Officer to take corrective action. Keep in mind that dogs barking in excess are subject to fines to the owner.

## DO YOUR DOO...TY

You are required to clean up after your pet. A clean environment encourages a pet to be clean and your neighbours will certainly appreciate your efforts.

It is especially important to clean up after your pet when walking your dog in the community as we all enjoy a clean and healthy environment.

## OFF-LEASH DOG PARK

*Looking for a place to walk to your dog?* Be sure to visit our off-leash dog park, located on the corner of 20th Avenue and 8th Street—just east of Coaldale Christian School and west of Owl's Nest campground.

Because it's within Town limits, the park is surrounded by a chainlink fence for the safety of the dogs and the peace of mind of people walking in the area.

## WALKING YOUR DOG & LEASHES

With the exception of the off-leash dog run, dogs must always be on a leash within Town limits.

Please note that dogs are not allowed in the Cemetery, school grounds, playgrounds or park areas.

## LICENSING & IDENTIFICATION

The Town of Coaldale does require a license be purchased yearly for your dog. Licenses are available at the Town Office. You can be fined if your dog is not licensed, so be sure you purchase your license as soon as possible.

All dogs over the age of 6 months must have a Town of Coaldale dog license which can be purchased at the Town Office. If you become a resident of the Town after 14 days you must license your dog.

The Town of Coaldale does have a dog pound. Should your pet become lost it is imperative you contact the Community Peace Officer as soon as possible. If your dog is licensed, the officer will be able to contact you if your pet is found. But be sure to still make that call as dogs have been known to lose their collars and identification.

The Town of Coaldale restricts the number of dogs per household to 3 dogs over 1 year old. If you would like to have up to 5 dogs, you are required to apply for a Fanciers License at the Town Office.

Common sense and kindness are the keys to success with your dog. Your expectation should meet the capability for the dog and not your human expectations.



## FINES & PENALTIES

Prohibited Areas:

No dogs shall be permitted in the following areas:

1. Cemetery
2. School Grounds
3. Within 30 metres of Playground or Park

### Finest associated to the above mentioned:

Dog Barking Excessively;

1. \$200.00

Failure to Clean up After Your Dog;

1. \$100.00

Dog in Prohibited Area

1. \$100.00

Unlicensed Dog;

1. \$100.00

Dog At Large;

1. Unlicensed \$250.00
2. Licensed \$100.00
