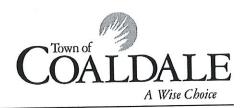

1.0 CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

Chairman J. Van Rijn called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

2.0 ADDITIONS TO / ADOPTION OF AGENDA:

MOTION: B. Wallace moved to adopt the agenda.

MOTION: R. Pitsol moved to approve the August 9, 2017 minutes.

5.0 NEW BUSINESS:

5.1 Development Application 2017-136
Discretionary Use
1502 – 8th Street

C. L'Hirondelle, Development and Environmental Services Manager, presented the Commission with Development Application 2017-136.

BACKGROUND/DESCRIPTION OF APPLICATION:

An application for the above mentioned address has been brought forward for an RV Sales, Service and Parts and RV storage in an already existing building.

Within the Industry - I zoning district Automotive Sales and Service is a discretionary use.

Notice of the application has been sent out to neighbouring property owners and no verbal or written concerns have been brought forward.

DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION OPTIONS:

The board may consider APPROVAL of Development Application (#2017-136) to construct a commercial building at the above referenced property subject to the following conditions:

- Must obtain <u>approval</u> of a Building Permit from Superior Safety Codes Inc at (403) 320-0734 <u>prior</u> to commencement.
- 2. The applicant/ owner shall comply with Land Use Bylaw No. 677-P-04-13, Schedule 11, Off-Street Parking & Loading Requirements.

A MINIMUM OF 12 PARKING STALLS MUST BE MAINTAINED ON THE PROPERTY

- 3. Excess dirt and mud that is tracked onto sidewalks and roads shall be cleaned up promptly as to not impact the neighbourhood.
- 4. Outdoor storage areas MUST be suitably enclosed by a fence or wall or screened with landscaping to the satisfaction of the Designated Officer or the Municipal Planning Commission as per Land Use Bylaw 677-P-04-13, Schedule 10, Industrial, Commercial and Warehousing Performance Standards.
- C. L'Hirondelle noted the application is for a change of use and she added there is sufficient parking.
- R. Dyck asked if they will be using inside of the building.
- C. L'Hirondelle said it will be used for the same use as it is currently being used.

MOTION: R. Hohm moved Development Application 2017-136 be approved with the conditions as noted.

5-0 CARRIED

5.2 Development Application 2017-137
Discretionary Use
1502-20th Avenue

C. L'Hirondelle, Development and Environmental Services Manager, presented the Commission with Development Application 2017-137.

BACKGROUND/DESCRIPTION OF APPLICATION:

An application for the above mentioned address has been brought forward for a rebuild of the existing attached garage and carport which is located at the rear of the existing Single-Detached dwelling.

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION 2017-137 - PART 1

The first part is for the existing covered front entry constructed without permits. There was an existing step and entry was removed and rebuilt larger than the previous entry. The covered front veranda is approximately 12' from the front property line.

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION 2017-137 - PART 2

The second part of the application is for demolition of the existing attached garage and carport and construction of a new attached garage and carport. The new garage and carport would be constructed on the same footprint as the existing structures. The setback from the north (rear) property line would be 1.37 feet.

DETAILS ON THE PROPERTY

This property is currently zoned Commercial C-1. The lot is 70' deep and 50' wide = 3480 sq ft. The property has a single detached dwelling which was built in 1965. The property is used for residential purposes rather than commercial uses.

Notice of the application has been sent out to neighbouring property owners and no verbal or written concerns have been brought forward.

DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION OPTIONS:

The board may consider APPROVAL of Development Application (#2017-137) to construct a commercial building at the above referenced property subject to the following conditions:

- Must obtain <u>approval</u> of a Building Permit from Superior Safety Codes Inc at (403) 320-0734 <u>prior</u> to commencement.
- 2. Must contact Alberta 1st Call (1-800-242-3447) and Dig Shaw (1-866-344-7429) to locate any utility lines *prior* to commencement.
- 3. Setbacks to conform to site plan that was attached as part of the Development Permit application and to the current Land Use Bylaw 677-P-04-13, Schedule 2, Commercial C-1.
- 4. Refuse and or garbage during construction shall be in appropriate containers and shall be properly screened and placed in an approved enclosure until removed for disposal.
- 5. Ensure lot drainage is maintained.
- 6. The building, when completed, shall meet or exceed provincial building requirements and comply with all provincial and municipal health and fire regulations.
- R. Pitsol asked if the original lot was divided in 1991.
- C. L'Hirondelle said the home was divided off.
- R. Pitsol asked if the owners had contacted building codes and he also reviewed a number of areas that they will need to address.
- J. Zwartbol noted they had a stop order initially and had to speak with the town. Next they were waiting on a bylaw rewrite so this is their third attempt. She said they were told at the time by the town's development officer that it could stay but they would have to get permission.

There was extensive discussion about the setback on the current site plan and the property dimensions.

- R. Pitsol encouraged them to speak with Superior on the building codes that apply to this application.
- C. L'Hirondelle confirmed, using the GIS, the dimensions of the lot as it is currently indicated.
- S. Croil suggested a RPR be required to clear up any confusion on the dimensions and setbacks.
- R. Dyck suggested a stake-out to confirm the setbacks at 1.3 metres.

C. L noted the stake-out is now part of new home builds in Coaldale.

There was general discussion on the stake-out and the need for a new RPR.

R. Pitsol asked if they would still require an inspection and if there will have to be another building permit for the demolition.

MOTION: B. Wallace moved Development Application 2017-137 covering the porch be approved subject to the conditions outlined in the staff report.

5-0 CARRIED

MOTION: moved Development Application 2017-137 covering the demolition be approved with the conditions as stated in the staff report and that an updated RPR and stake-out be submitted and approved by the development authority and that there be no less than five feet between the wall of the garage and the side yard property line.

5.3 Development Application 2017-138
Freestanding Sign- Height Waiver
2805-21st Avenue

C. L'Hirondelle, Development and Environmental Services Manager, presented the Commission with Development Application 2017-138.

BACKGROUND/DESCRIPTION OF APPLICATION:

The above mentioned property currently has building supplies store under construction and the Town of Coaldale has received a development permit application for a 32' high and 193.6 Square foot freestanding sign.

FREESTANDING SIGN

The site plan for the commercial lot shows the proposed height of the free standing sign to be **32'** whereas **25'** is the maximum height and the sign face area of the freestanding sign to be 193.6 square feet whereas 161.4 square feet is the maximum size that is set out in the current Land Use Bylaw 677-P-04-13, Schedule 13, Sign regulations. And, a free standing sign within the Highway Commercial – C-2 zoning district is a discretionary use as set out in the current Land Use Bylaw 677-P-04-13, Schedule 2, Highway Commercial – C-2.

Other free standing signs in the area or approved for the area are as follows:

- Tim Horton's, existing, 6.6 meters (21.6 ft) tall
- McDonalds, existing, 13.7 meters (45 feet) tall
- Fas Gas, existing, 15.2 meters (40 feet) tall

Notice of the application was sent to adjacent properties and no concern has been brought forward to date. Alberta Transportation and Lethbridge County have been notified

OPTIONS:

The board may consider APPROVAL of Development Application (#2017-138) subject to the following recommended conditions:

- 1. Must obtain <u>approval</u> of a Building Permit from Superior Safety Codes Inc at (403) 320-0734 <u>prior</u> to commencement.
- 2. Must contact Alberta 1st Call (1-800-242-3447) and Dig Shaw (1-866-344-7429) to locate any utility lines *prior* to commencement.
- 7. Setbacks to conform to site plan that was attached as part of the Development Permit application and to the current Land Use Bylaw 677-P-04-13, Schedule 13, Sign Regulations.
- 8. Applicant/owner shall comply with Land Use Bylaw 677-P-04-13, Schedule 13, Sign Regulations. The freestanding sign shall not exceed 9.8 meters (32 feet) in height.
- C. L'Hirondelle the application is for both a height and square footage waiver for a new sign.
- R. Pitsol asked if the sign is coming out of Ontario.
- R. Heinen said it is contracted locally based on a design from head office.
- J. Van Rijn noted a similar waiver has already been granted for other businesses in the same area.

There was some discussion on the style of the sign and its position.

- R. Dyck asked if there was anything about message duration and other requirements in the Land Use Bylaw.
- S. Croil said the sign area would require a waiver as it is larger than others in the area.
- R. Dyck said a lot of municipalities have put a limit on the duration of electronic sign messaging, noting some require the message to be static for 8 seconds, not just firing off like fireworks.
- C L'Hirondelle said Alberta Transportation as the same guidelines.
- R. Hohm said that would make sense as it is the standard out there.
- R. Dyck reviewed the requirements under the Land Use Bylaw and noted since it is a discretionary use, the MPC could place requirements on the sign messaging.
- S. Croil questioned if the McDonald's sign was required to meet specific messaging guidelines.
- C. L'Hirondelle said due to its positions along the highway it is governed by Alberta Transportation guidelines.
- S. Croil questioned, due to the fact the Home Hardware sign is in close proximity to the highway could it not also be covered under the same requirements.
- B. Wallace questioned what would happen if the commission required the sign to meet the surface area outlined in the bylaw.
- S. Croil said it would have to be redesigned, scaled to fit. His concern is whether the height is relevant any more, whether it needs to be addressed.

There was general discussion about the overall area of the sign and the requirement for both a height and square footage waiver. The commission also reviewed the Alberta Transportation requirements.

- J. Van Rijn suggested the best approach would be to follow the guidelines of Alberta Transportation. He addressed the requested waiver for the overall square footage of the sign.
- S. Croil said they are about 3 square metres larger than they should be with the sign.
- J. Van Rijn questioned if the pilings are already in place, noting the waiver should have been addressed before that footprint was established. If not approved the sign would have to be scaled to fit the pilings.
- S. Croil said if the commission decides to require the applicant to reduce the sign size, they can appeal.
- R. Pitsol noted the sign is probably already made.
- B. Wallace questioned if the height is higher than the others in the area.

- C. L'Hirondelle noted both McDonald's and Fas Gas signs are higher.
- J. Van Rijn said as he understands it the physical size of the Home Hardware sign is fine but that electronic component makes it higher.
- S. Croil said they could reduce it by taking out a sign element.
- J. Van Rijn questioned if the waivers are approved for this sign would it be setting a precedent.
- R. Pitsol questioned if the sign can be lowered.
- C. L'Hirondelle said there is the issue of line of sight, the opening has to be 10 feet.

There was general discussion on the calculations for the height of the sign elements.

- R. Pitsol said the sign could be brought down by a foot.
- J. Van Rijn said the height is not the issue, it is the overall area.
- R. Hohm questioned if the elements are split does it make it two different signs.
- J. Van Rijn questioned the impact of approving these waivers.
- S. Croil said by following the bylaw the sign is more scaled with a small town.
- R. Hohm said is the assumption made that this sign is the same for Home Hardware stores across the country.
- R. Dyck said they are used to working with the sign requirements in different municipalities.
- J. Van Rijn questioned if the commission members are ok with the waiver for the square footage of the sign.
- R. Hohm questioned if anyone driving by on the highway would even know the sign is larger in square footage than others in the area.

MOTION: R. Hohm moved Development Application 2017-138 be approved under the stated conditions with a waiver for both the height and square footage of the sign.
