# Sign up today for Town of Coaldale recreation and culture classes

With the start of a new year comes new recreation and culture classes offered through the Town of Coaldale.

Programs range from Nia to Zumba and from pasta to photography. There are also art classes and a class on making your own body products. This is the second year the Town of Coaldale has offered recreation and culture classes previously hosted by the County of Lethbridge Community Learning Council.

A change to the CLCLC's mandate meant it was no longer able to offer classes under the banner of general interest courses which included recreation and culture related programming. Over the past year the town's Community Services Department has taken over these programs in Coaldale.

## ***Emergency Services Fire Prevention Tip***

January's message from Coaldale Emergency Services deals with the disposal of fire place and wood stove ashes. Residents are reminded to place ashes into a metal bucket and soak ashes. Stir and soak again, being sure the entire contents are wet. Ashes can remain hot for several days after the fire place or stove was last used. Also with the cold weather here now check to be sure your block heater and extension cords are in good condition and do not overload circuits. To save on your power bill consider using block heater timers.
