In order to address an error in the current solid waste pickup schedule for the Town of Coaldale, a new schedule has been mailed out to residents.

The new schedule covers October 2018 through to the end of 2019. Residents should check their mailboxes for the new schedule and begin using it as of October 1, 2018.

Updated schedules are also posted to the Town's website at www.coaldale.ca in both colour and black and white.

Copies of the schedule are also available at the Town Office. The new schedule is a 15-month schedule for compost, garbage and recycling that will take the pick-ups all they way through until the end of December next year.
